The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) approved San Jose Water's General Rate Case for the years 2022 through 2024. The 2022 rate increase went into effect on November 1. Check out the new expanded tiers with lower rates. Use less than 12 CCFs per month and pay lower rates!

SJW Rates at Work


San Jose Water's maintenance program conducts regular valve repairs to ensure they are in good operating condition. Our system has more than 35,000 valves within our 140-square-mile system.
